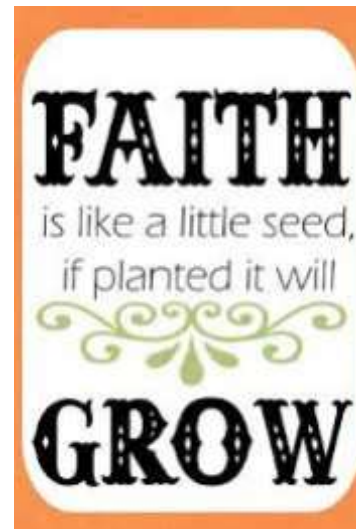


GraceLand - a place full of God's grace... where children learn the love of Jesus and how to shine His light everyday. Sundays at 9am for Nursery to Gr. 6

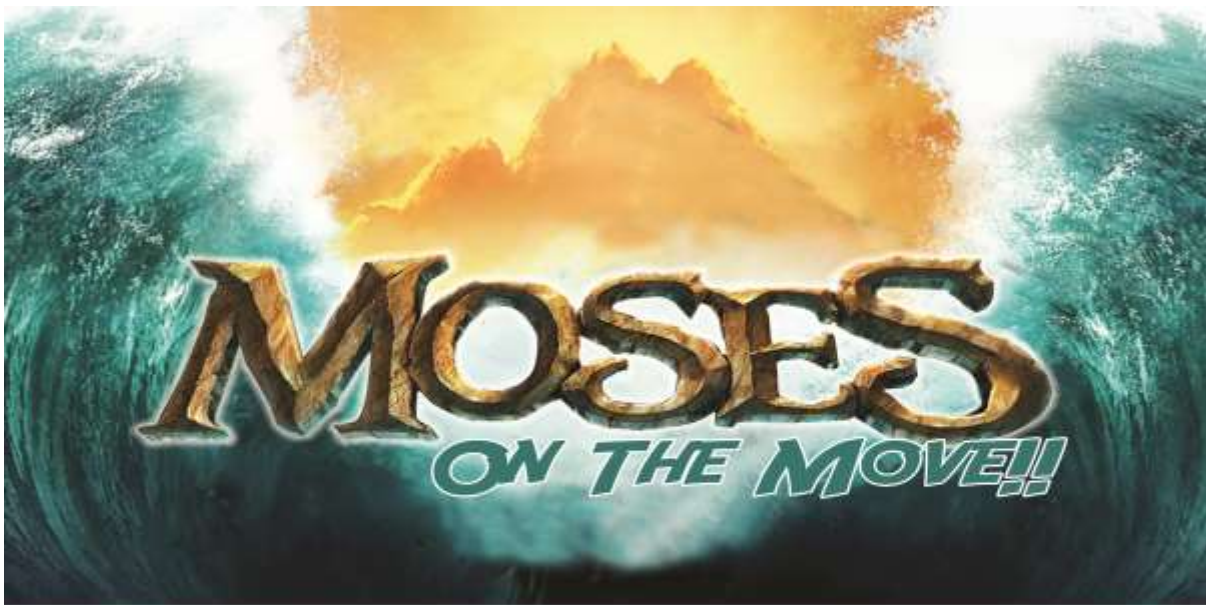
If you are not already participating in group life, here are the benefits of being in a healthy small group:
