Born in Hamilton, Ontario, following studies at **McMaster University and Queen's Theological College**, Dave was Ordained by Hamilton Conference in 1990. Settlement to the Edson Trail Pastoral Charge in the Peace River country of North-Western Alberta, was followed by 9 years with the Fordwich Pastoral Charge, London Conference, Huron-Perth Presbytery, and 14 years with Trinity, Elmira, Hamilton Conference, Waterloo Presbytery.

Starting the Stewardship & Gifts Officer position in June 2016 has been an exciting change and allows Dave to share his experience, creativity, and enthusiasm for Stewardship in a wider ministry context. Dave consults with congregations and individuals around all areas of Stewardship and generosity including: congregational giving programs, Mission & Service, Planned Legacy Giving, and the United Church Foundation. Dave is married to Deb and they have 3 adult sons, 3 daughters-in-law and 2 grand-dogs. Dave and Deb live just north of Kitchener-Waterloo in Elmira.

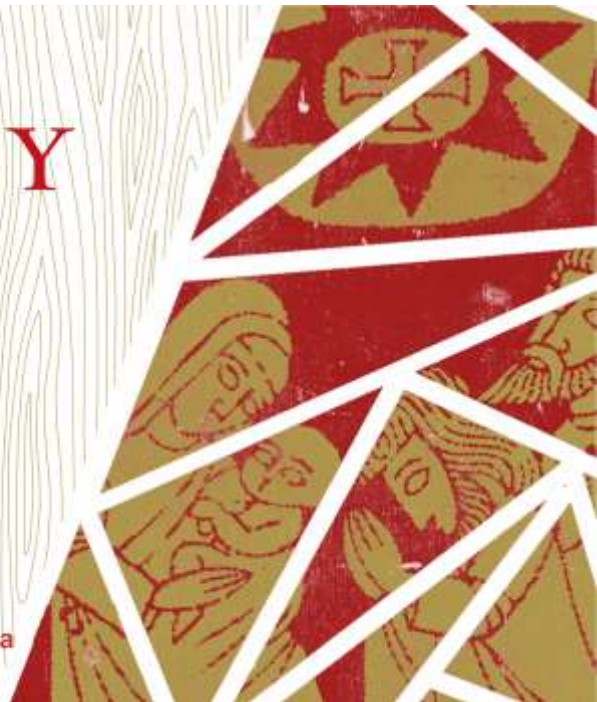

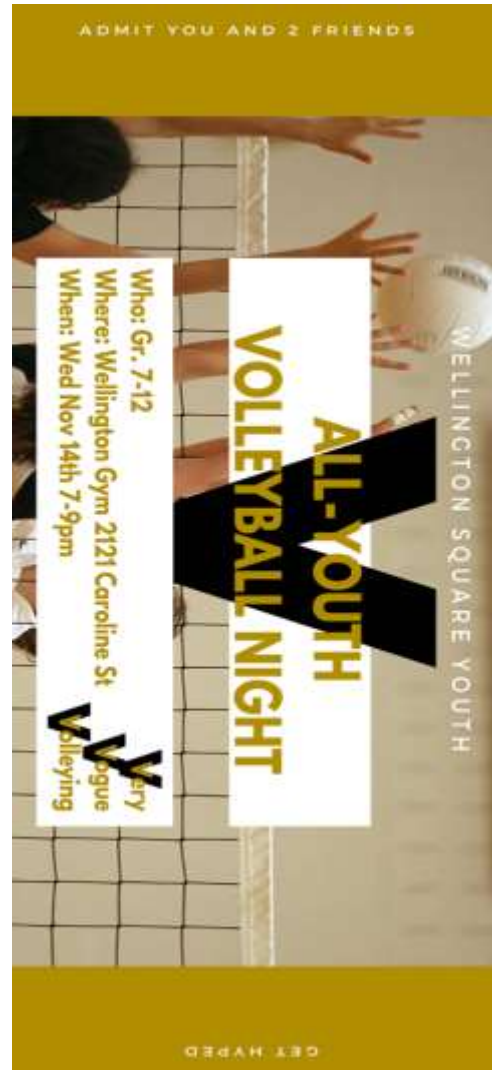

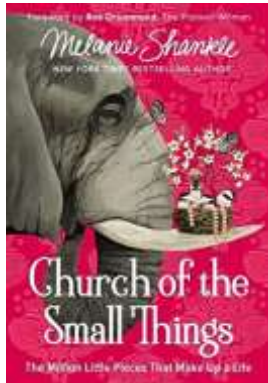
