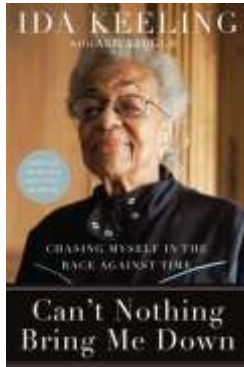

Can't Nothing Bring Me Down: Chasing
Myself in the Race Against Time
By Ida Keeling, with Anita Diggs

Ida Keeling shares her inspirational story about growing up as a child of immigrants during the Depression and later raising four children as a single mother. At the age of 67, after the brutal, drug-related murders of her sons, she found her way back into the land of hope by taking up running. She went on to set world records for her age, and now, over 100 years old, is still hitting the track! Telling her remarkable story, Ida offers time-tested truths gathered from a lifetime of watching a nation change and from a life-long **faith in Jesus. "Every night, I thank him for my many blessings, for his guidance, for his protection,"** Ida says, **"And every night he tells me, 'Miss Ida, you just keep on, because I ain't done with you yet.'"**



The Singing Strummers are an Outreach group that has been going for over 32 years. They perform in nursing homes, retirement homes, recovery groups and churches, among others; a focus is on reaching folks who are not readily able to get to entertainment venues.

The Singing Strummers are a nine person guitar/banjo band with harmonizing vocalists. They sing and play both religious and secular music and play songs that are familiar and encourage audiences to sing and sometimes dance along.
