

Update from the COVID-19 Re-opening Committee

Dear Wellington Square United Church Family:

The COVID-19 Re-opening Committee met this week to evaluate our current situation with respect to safety measures. As you know, we had extended the wearing of masks due to the 6th wave of COVID and to help keep everyone as safe as possible. We have decided after input from the Committee, Staff, Ministry & Personnel Committee, and reviewing current provincial health guidelines, that as of Monday June 27th, masks will no longer be mandatory at the church; they will be optional.

The band and choir will continue to sing behind shields as an additional effort to provide a safe environment for worship. Starting Sunday July 3rd, you will also be able to return to bringing your coffee or beverage of choice into the sanctuary/church. We will provide more updates later in the summer about return to coffee time after the service.

Masks will also no longer be required as of June 27th, for meetings, groups, events and rentals, however, the leadership of any meeting, group, event or rental may continue to require that masks be worn if they so choose.
