BIMBI IRRIGATION

HAHFA has partnered with Pastor Moses of the Word of Grace Church, to help bring life-giving water to a 35 hectare irrigation site.

This has allowed crops to be grown year round, reducing food shortages in the Bimbi area, with phase One alone helping 280 families.
